







What is 8th grade Science all about?

This course will provide foundational understanding of chemistry and physics. Students will explore physical and chemical properties of matter, the atom and periodic table, bonding, chemical reactions and energy forms. The course emphasizes scientific thinking as a way of understanding the natural phenomena that surround us. For physics, the topics of study include motion, forces, energy, Newton's Laws, waves, electricity and magnetism. It includes real and virtual lab exercises and gives students the skills to discuss a number of scientific topics, understand how science is used in their daily lives, and become comfortable with solving simple algebraic expressions that support scientific laws.




