

## TRUSTEE RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ELECTION BY MAIL BALLOT

BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees for the Bigfork School District No. 38, of Flathead County, State of Montana, will hold the Annual Regular School Election by mail ballot on Tuesday, the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2021, which date is not less than seventy (70) days after the passage of this resolution.

The election will be held by mail ballot. The designated place of deposit will be located at Bigfork School District 38, District Office, 600 Commerce Street, Bigfork, MT 59911. On the day of election, ballots will be accepted at this location from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.

The purpose of the election is to elect one (1) trustee for a three-year term, from Swan River Elementary District.

If it is later determined that any portion of the election is not required, the Board of Trustees authorizes Lacey Porrovecchio, election administrator, to cancel that portion of the election in accordance with 13-1-304 and 20-3-313, MCA.

Three electors of this district who are qualified to vote at such election are hereby appointed to act as judges at the election as follows:
