Our *primary* purpose of the FUN RUN is to promote good health by giving students the opportunity to have fun while they get out and move. The added bonus is that we get to raise money to support our school community. Here is how it works...

**We have a school wide goal - 100% participation!**

**Every student should strive to get at least 1 pledge or donation.**

(Remember, this is also a **fundraiser**, the more pledges/donations, the more money we raise for our school!)

There are two ways people can pledge/donate:

1. **Make a one-time flat donation** - this is a great option if you have a business or know someone who has a business!
2. **Make a pledge** -
  - Your child will set a goal for the number of laps he/she would like to run/walk on the school track during the 30 minute time period.
  - You, your family, and friends can pledge an amount per lap.
  - Once your child completes the FUN RUN, she/he will collect the pledged amounts from each donor.

# Fun Run Facts and Key Dates

## May 31st- FUN RUN DAY

### Running Schedule:

- **Blue Group - 1:00-1:30- Kindergarten, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, and 6th grade**
- **Red Group- 1:40-2:10- 1<sup>st</sup> grade, 4<sup>th</sup> grade, and 7th grade**
- **Black Group- 2:20-2:50- 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 5<sup>th</sup> grade, and 8th grade**

**June 1st**- All pledge/donations due to the school.\*

**June 5-7**- Prizes awarded - 3 Prize Opportunities!\*

**1. Class Who Raised the Most Money = Pizza Party**

- 3 pizza parties will be awarded to 3 different grades within a grade band.
- Grade bands- K-2 , 3-5, 6-8
  - One winner will be chosen from each of these grade bands. For example, if kindergarten raises the most money in the K-2 grade band, they will win a pizza party. Pizza parties will most likely be the last week of school.

**2. Group Spirit Award = Ice cream treat**

- The group who shows the most school spirit while running will win an ice cream treat

**Blue Group** - Kindergarten, 3rd grade, & 6th Grade.

**Red Group** - 1st grade, 4th grade, & 7th Grade

**Black Group** - 2nd grade, 5th grade, & 8th grade.

- This is where the **color wars** come into play. Judges will be looking for groups with the most color, creativity, AND enthusiasm!

**3. Gift Baskets Raffle**

- PTA has put together 8 themed gift baskets (Lego, Family Game Night, Outdoor Games, Summer Fun, Arts & Crafts, Graphic Novels, Sports Basket and STEM)!
- Each student will receive one raffle ticket to be placed in a bucket near the basket of choice. The students will receive an additional raffle ticket for every \$50 raised. Raffle tickets will be drawn the last week of school.

\***NOTE:** Any contributions received after June 1 **will not** be factored into any class prizes. Pledge forms should be returned to your child's classroom teacher. Middle school students should return forms to Mrs. Venegas (our school secretary).
