Ten Cave Club members will be establishing monitoring in Froggs Fault Cave, which is in the Pryor Mts of Montana, but easiest to approach from Wyoming. The students will be developing data for a final report and GIS driven web application. Last April (2023) club members established monitoring in the east passages, but did not have enough time to establish monitorin in the west passages.

Students have been developing GIS layers, reports and apps for caves throughout MT as part of a cost share agreement with the US Forest Service.


