IT'S FUN RUN TIME!

Dear Bigfork Parents/Guardians,

PTA and Bigfork School are excited for our **annual Bigfork School PTA Fun Run!** This year's run is scheduled for **Wednesday, May 22nd** and includes all students **K-8**. Our *primary* purpose of the FUN RUN is to promote good health by giving students the opportunity to have fun while they get out and move. The **added bonus** is that we get to raise money to support our school community. Here is how it works...

We have a school wide goal - 100% participation!

Every student should strive to get at least 1 pledge or donation. (Remember, this is also a **fundraiser**, the more pledges/donations, the more money we raise for our school!)

There are two ways people can pledge/donate:

1. **Make a flat donation** - Not per lap, just a flat donation to the Fun Run. For example, a donation of \$25.00 to a student for their efforts.
2. **Make a pledge per lap** -
 - Your child will set a goal for the number of laps he/she would like to run/walk on the school track during the 30-minute time period.
 - You, your family, and friends can pledge an amount per lap.
 - Once your child completes the FUN RUN, she/he will collect the pledged amounts from each donor.

1. **Grade Who Raised the Most Money = Pizza Party**

 - o **Judges will be looking for groups with the most color, creativity, AND enthusiasm!**
3. **Raffle Prizes**
 - o PTA has put together some fun prizes! 2 students from each grade level will be randomly selected from the raffle bucket to pick a prize.
 - o Each fundraising student will receive one raffle ticket. The students will receive an additional raffle ticket for every \$25 raised. Raffle tickets will be drawn on May 28th.

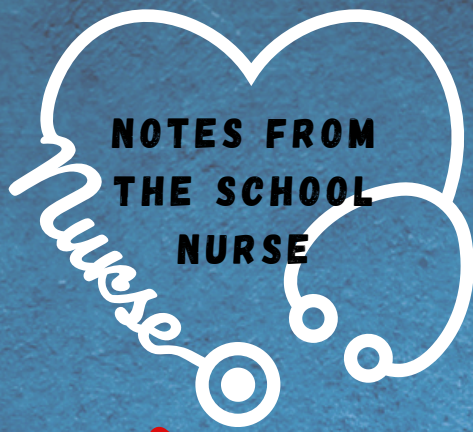

Haemophilus influenza Type B (Hib)	1 dose (given on or after the 1 st birthday, unless child is older than 59 months) ²	None Needed
Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTaP, Tdap)	4 doses	4 doses (one dose must be given on or after 4 th birthday) ^{3,4} Plus 1 dose of Tdap (prior to entering 7 th grade) ⁶
Polio (IPV or OPV)	3 doses	3 doses (one dose must be given on or after 4 th birthday) ³
Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR)	1 dose (dose must be given on or after 1 st birthday)	2 doses (first dose must be given on or after 1 st birthday, and spacing between doses is 4 weeks)
